The Workshop

Domestic violence affects one in four women and an increasing number of men. Health care providers are often the first people outside the home to see the injuries caused by domestic violence.

This information-packed workshop will provide you with assessment tools and resources to quickly and effectively assess this pervasive problem.

Elliott A. Schulman, MD will discuss refractory pain which is a common health care problem found in victims of abuse.

Arlene Smalls, MD will discuss effects of domestic violence regarding pregnancy and fetal development.

Program Objectives

- ❖ List various scenarios that constitute abuse
- ❖ Recognize health effects of abuse
- ❖ Recognize warning signs of DV in obstetric patients
- ❖ Discuss risk factors to the fetus
